Barriers

 Only 9% of Polish people have ever had an HIV test (prof. Z. Izdebski & Polpharma "Polish sexuality 2011 Research")

Objectives of the Foundations are as follows

Organizing conferences, lectures and workshops for different groups of professionals and presenting the results of national research at international venues.



HIV testing service

- Diagnostic and Consultation Points in Warsaw
- Free and anonymous testing
- All types of testing including rapid tests
- Psychological support
- Test and Keep in Care (TAK) project: after HIV diagnosis care.
 - Increased risk of further infections due to disregarding health risk of sexual contact.
 - Counselling and greater awareness about HIV improves the link with professional health care services


